In the month of April we had 60 people visit Oahu Central Office and provided literature to 57 of those guests. We had a total of 217 calls during business hours, of those 12 were 12 step in nature; 147 were regarding meetings times and locations and 77 were for information and the balance (5) requests for literature.
