- **Progress on 2017 goals:**
 - ⇒ Utilize the OIG Panel 67 structures & Guidelines – we made some progress on this goal in 2017 as several Intergroup Reps, utilized the S&G in the November OIG Business meeting. As well several IGR's have submitted request for proposals correctly based on the outline provided in the S&G.
 - ⇒ Adhere to the Suggested 2017 OIG Budget – We did an excellent job in this area as we only spent \$6.00 over budget in 2017. We have identified several new line items for 2018. We will provide a new 2018 Budget before the 2/7/18 OIG Business meeting.
 - ⇒ Increase the number of OIG Activities to offset the financial burdened placed on the groups, and increase unity and opportunities for service & unity –
 - ⇒ Increase group participation –
 - We exceeded this goal as OIG has hosted 9 events in 2017 to promote unity and support the fellowship of Alcoholics Anonymous on Oahu.
 - ⇒ Create an OIG Newsletter –
 - No progress yet ☹
 - ⇒ Build our prudent reserve
 - Due to reduced group and individual contributions in 2017 we were unable to increase the prudent reserve in 2017.
 - ⇒ Create an Activity Fund
 - We created an activity fund, but found it was not as useful as originally thought and dissolved this into our Operating Fund 12/31/17
 - ⇒ Increase the number of in office volunteers to 34
 - Some progress we currently have 25 in office volunteers + 2 volunteers who come in specifically to work on special projects
