The Oahu Central Office and its volunteers supported the AA groups on Oahu through the following activities in February:

- **2018 Events in progress –**

- ⇒ Founder's Day – Tayshea K.

- **Central Office volunteers:**

- ⇒ Helped coordinate **11; 12 step calls;**

- four of those calls were handled by an after hour phone angel;

- ⇒ Assisted **3** individuals with **transportation** to meetings;

- ⇒ Provided information and **assistance** to **197 callers;**

- ⇒ Sold \$1,593.20 worth of literature for a profit of \$418.55;

- ⇒ Welcomed **45 visitors** to Oahu Central Office;

- ⇒ Trained **1** new volunteers in **May;**

- Unfortunately **5** volunteers secured promotions and had to let go of volunteering at Central Office and 6 are on leave;

- ⇒ We currently have **20** in office volunteers covering **34** shifts;

- ⇒ **2** special project volunteers, and

- ⇒ Interviewed **1** new perspective volunteer.

- **After-Hours Phone Angel** volunteers assisted **190 callers;** and

- ⇒ Coordinated **4; 12<sup>th</sup> step call.**

- ⇒ We currently have **20** After-Hour Phone Angels covering **21** shifts.

- ⇒ 3 Phone Angels Volunteers are covering more than one shift

- **12<sup>th</sup> Step** volunteers assisted **11 callers;** and

- ⇒ We currently have **22 men & 19 women** volunteering for 12<sup>th</sup> Step work; covering all 7 Districts on Oahu

- **Transportation** volunteers assisted **3 callers;** and

- ⇒ We increased from 6 to **7 groups** in May, as well we have 10 men and 11 women from the 12<sup>th</sup> step list volunteering to transport visitors, new comers and our elders to AA meetings on Oahu.

- **Translation** volunteers assisted **0 callers;** and

- ⇒ We currently have **11 members** willing to translate French, Filipino, Japanese, Spanish, Chinese, Korean and Russian.
