OIG Treasury Report - Rochelle A., OIG Treasurer

Thank you for your patience and understanding. My trip to Vietnam was the trip of a lifetime! The following reports were reviewed noting the difficulty with PayPal batched electronic payments processed without sufficient detail for proper accounting entry. Please avoid using PayPal if possible. We are also still seeking Tech help at the office that might help alleviate this problem

going forward. Contributions received in October were insufficient to meet expenses, so a transfer of \$4,000 from the Prudent reserve occurred near month end. The Proposed Budget devised in August based on the first six months actuals was updated with PY 2023 & 2024 data as requested at 2025.10.08 OIG Mtg. Small print size was noted and going forward will be avoided in the 2027 Budget proposal. Treasurer noted prior years were compared: 2025 \$65K, 2024 \$65K, 2023 \$64K, but 2021 \$69K, so proposed 2026 Budget of \$70 is in line with prior budget trends and responsibly adjusts the Oahu CO Mgr POSITION compensation as required, which has not been done by the SC since 2021. Though the current trusted servant has been in the position 41 months without COLA, Oahu CO Mgr has maintained a cheerful attitude and welcoming presence. The treasurer asks you to support the budget so the CO runs effectively. This budget can be met with an additional \$6.50 contribution per month from each of the 75 contributing groups (\$78 per year per group). DCCA was questioned - normally an annual report, but had to be updated with change in officers multiple times in 2025. Serenity Group prefers no raise until performance evaluation complete: reiterated the increase is a POSITIONAL cost of living adjustment required to keep compensation current with market, not a performance/merit increase. Any performance review would not affect POSITION compensation. Treasurer noted working on bank reconciliation for October: \$8. discrepancy in electronic payment as mentioned. IGR-Malia Discussion noted the group had recently made up their prudent reserve shortfall and group contributions would be resuming.

 - i. ByLaws and S&G specify the second Wednesday of the month at the time and place of the OIG Chair's choosing. There is nothing in the ByLaws or S&G about not meeting in December.
